





Hey! Thank you for purchasing the Throwback Bikes R-S MOLLE Pannier Plates
 Before beginning, please read all instructions.
 Lets get these installed!

In the Box:



Hardware:

-  Qty. 10
-  Qty. 20
-  Qty. 10

2 MOLLE plates, 1 Support/License Plate Bracket hardware, and stickers!

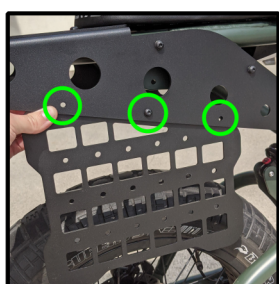
Not in the Box:



3mm Hex Key and 8mm Wrench OR Socket



1. Start by getting washers onto 6 of the bolts. You'll use 3 on each side along with 3 washers and 3 nuts on each side.



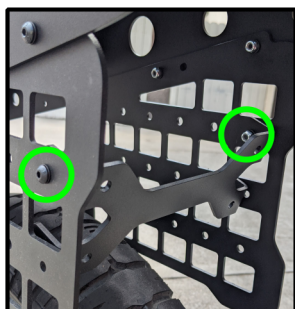
2. Align a MOLLE plate with the mounting holes along the lower edge of the R-S Back Rack side brace.



3. Insert a bolt and washer through the brace and the MOLLE Plate. Place a washer and a nut on the back side and thread into place. **DO NOT TIGHTEN YET.** We'll get to that later I promise ;)



4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the remaining top holes for both the Left and Right side MOLLE Plates.



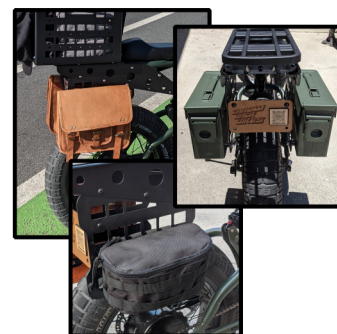
5. Next, you'll need the support/license plate bracket. Orient the bracket at the rear of the MOLLE plates with the mouning tabs facing towards the front of the bike. Align the bracket so the holes match-up with the uppermost and rearmost holes in the MOLLE plates.



6. Place bolts with washers through each of the 4 holes. Washers and nuts are then threaded onto the bolts from the inside. Ensure all the hardware is started but not tight yet.



7. Once all hardware is started, tighten all bolts and nuts with a 3mm allen key and 8mm wrench. Don't over-do it. These nyloc nuts will stay snug for many miles to come.



8. Strap-down a bag, bolt-on a box, or tie-on whatever your heart desires. Bungee cords and cargo-nets work great with these as well!

IMPORTANT. Periodically check that the mounting and assembly hardware is secure. Always secure cargo well to the plates. Plates not designed for heavy offroad use. Do not overload the plates beyond the rating of the rack it is mounted to. FUN FACT: These plates can mount directly to the bike, but they are designed to mount to our R-S Back Rack and we think thats how they look best. Anyhow, go be nice to others. Post pics. Have fun!
